

Year-End Finance Reminders

- **Pledges**: Please review your pledge and prayerfully consider bringing it up to date by the end of the year.
- Stock Donations: If you wish to donate stock, or have money sent directly to the church from a
 financial institution, please contact <u>Deb Angerman</u>, for instructions. Also let Deb know what the
 money is designated for and to whose account it should be credited.
- End of Year Contributions: Contributions must be claimed in the years they were delivered, per the Diocese of Virginia. A contribution must either be in the hands of the church or postmarked by December 31, 2024, to be considered a contribution for 2024. Pre-dated checks delivered to the church or postmarked after the end of the year will be considered contributions for 2025.
- Receipts for reimbursement are due to the office by December 31.
